DEADLINE TO SUBMIT NOMINATION PACKAGE: NOVEMBER 15, 2017

The University of British Columbia (UBC) and the Mastercard Foundation have partnered to provide full scholarships to academically promising undergraduate students from sub-Saharan Africa. The vision of the program is to educate bright yet economically marginalized young people in Africa who have demonstrated a “give-back” commitment and who seek to use their education to contribute to the transformation of the continent.

Nominations for **The Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program (MCFSP) at the University of British Columbia, Vancouver campus** will be accepted from secondary schools and recognized international development agencies and their affiliates, or registered local or international charitable and not-for-profit organizations. Each school or organization **may nominate a maximum of three students**. Prospective undergraduate students nominated for the MCFSP at UBC **may not** additionally be nominated for the International Leader of Tomorrow Award or the Donald Wehrung International Student Award at UBC.

To be eligible for consideration for **The Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program at UBC**, the nominee must:

- be a citizen of a sub-Saharan African country whose permanent residence is in sub-Saharan Africa;
- present economically disadvantaged financial circumstances correspondent to that of the lowest two quintiles of their country’s socio-economic scale, and be able to show they lack financial means from family or other sources to pursue post-secondary (university) education in their home country or elsewhere;
- **have a very strong academic record (‘A’s)** and meet UBC’s admissions requirements, including UBC’s English Language Admission Standard (visit <http://you.ubc.ca> for detailed admissions information);
- have a record of service, extra-curricular involvement and leadership in their school and/or community;
- be graduating/recently graduated from a recognized senior secondary school;
- be applying for their first undergraduate degree in one of the following Faculties at UBC’s Vancouver campus:
 - Faculty of Arts (Bachelor of Arts)
 - Vancouver School of Economics (Bachelor of International Economics)
 - Faculty of Applied Science (Engineering)
 - Faculty of Forestry
 - Faculty of Land & Food Systems (including Global Resource Systems; Food, Nutrition & Health; Applied Biology (Applied Animal Biology, Applied Plant & Soil Sciences or Food & the Environment))
 - Faculty of Science
 - Sauder School of Business (Bachelor of Commerce)
- be an international student who will be studying at UBC on a Canadian Study Permit;
- demonstrate a commitment to returning to Africa immediately after graduation from UBC and giving back to his/her home community in ways that enhance the economic growth and social development of Africa.

Convention refugees, students intending to become landed immigrants to Canada, and students who have already entered or completed post-secondary schooling are **not** eligible for consideration for this award. The decisions of the Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program Selection Committee on all nominations are final.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR NOMINEE AND SCHOOL /NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION

THE NOMINEE:

1. 2018 Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program Nomination Package:

(i) Complete all parts of **SECTIONS 1 AND 3**. If you do not have your UBC student number by November 15, leave it blank. We will fill the number in for you.

2. The Online Admission Application (and special procedure):

An application to a UBC undergraduate program and a nomination for the **Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program** are separate processes, and will be independently evaluated.

Complete an application for undergraduate admission to UBC. The application form is available online at **you.ubc.ca**. Use your full legal name exactly as it appears in your passport or other official documentation.

The normal application procedure requires payment of application fees before the application can be submitted electronically. Mastercard Foundation Scholarship nominees **DO NOT** have to pay these fees, and you must therefore follow a special procedure in order to submit your Admission Application.

Admission Application special procedure:

- (i) The **nominating school** or organization must first inform us that you are being nominated by completing the **2018 Nomination Notification Form for UBC Awards**. They must provide your **first name, middle name(s), surname** and **date of birth** exactly as it will appear in your UBC undergraduate Admission Application, by **November 1, 2017 or earlier**. If you do not have a middle name, leave it blank.
- (ii) You should then visit **you.ubc.ca**, follow the instructions to create a Campus Wide Login (CWL) account, and then **fully complete** the online Admission Application. **DO NOT complete the 'Residence Application' section for student residence**. Once scholarship recipients are selected, we will advise on applying for student residence.
- (iii) You may give **first and second choice programs**, which must be offered **at the Vancouver campus** by the Faculties listed on the first page. (*Note that programs at or jointly offered with other institutions are not open to nominees of the scholarship program.*)
- (iv) When the Admission Application has been completed, you should 'save' it **and** 'submit' it, but **DO NOT** pay the application fee. After you submit your application, you will be given your UBC student number. This number should be included in the nomination submission where indicated, and **used in all correspondence** with UBC.
- (v) You must then complete the [2018 Admissions Application Completion Form for UBC Awards](#). When notification is received, UBC will waive the application fee on your behalf. Due to the volume of nominations, this may take 1-2 weeks.

Required Documents for Undergraduate Admission:

- (i) Transcripts: See (3) in the Nominating School/Non-Profit Organization section.
- (ii) All nominees must satisfy the University's **English Language Admission Standard (ELAS)** – see [you.ubc.ca](#). Official test scores must be sent directly to UBC by the testing agency and be received by UBC by **January 31, 2018**.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR NOMINEE AND SCHOOL/NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION

THE NOMINATING SCHOOL/NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION:

1. The **nominating school** or organization must complete the [2018 Nomination Notification Form for UBC Awards](#) to confirm the full legal name and date of birth of their nominee by **November 1, 2017 or earlier**.

2. The nominating school/non-profit organization must:

- complete **SECTIONS 2.1 – 2.3**. Only references from the three referees shown will be accepted. Family members or friends cannot serve as references.
- review the financial section (**SECTION 3.1 – 3.13**) once it has been completed, and
- sign the declaration in **SECTION 3.14**.

3. **Required Documents for Undergraduate Admission:**

Once the online application is complete, UBC Admissions will send the applicant an email detailing what documents are required. **Nominees must ensure their school is aware of these document requirements.** For timely evaluation of the Admission Application, we ask that schools **submit the requested documents, if available, with the nomination package**, by the Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program **deadline of November 15, 2017**. (The documents will be forwarded to UBC Undergraduate Admissions). If transcripts and/or certificates are not available by this date, the **student may upload** the **document(s)** to their admissions application if this option is available, or the school may email a certified copy of the document(s) to mcf.undergrad@ubc.ca by **January 31, 2018**. **The document deadline given by Undergraduate Admissions does not apply to MCFSP nominees.**

(i) **Transcript(s):** Grades 9 to 11 and Grade 12 interim/mid-year transcript, and if applicable, mock, pre-board or predicted final grades for courses that are still in progress. In British-patterned education, certified copies of GCSE 'O' Level, GCE 'AS', 'A' Level certificates, and predicted 'AS' or 'A' Level grades from the original examining school(s) are required. If a student has completed high school, submit transcripts and the secondary school certificate. A certified copy must bear the original school stamp and signature of an official.

The UBC Admissions Office will accept scanned transcripts and certificates that are uploaded by the student or emailed by the school. Following the selection process, UBC will require the Mastercard Foundation Scholarship recipients and their schools to supply official transcripts and certificates.

Transcripts must be in the original language of instruction. If the transcript is in a language other than English or French, a certified translation by a recognized translation agency must be provided.

(ii) A **school profile** or description of the institution the nominee is currently attending, if available.

4. **Submitting the Mastercard Foundation Scholars Program Package**

The school/non-profit organization must send the **completed** nomination package containing the MCFSP nomination, official transcript(s) and other supporting documentation in a **sealed, school/organization envelope, with school/organization stamp across the envelope flap**, to:

We strongly recommend you use international courier services, as regular mail may take several weeks to reach Canada and UBC. Late or incomplete packages **cannot be accepted** and UBC is not responsible for nomination packages not received by the deadline.

OR nominators may scan the completed package in **.pdf format** and email it, preferably from a school or organization email address to mcf.undergrad@ubc.ca. Email it as one document, or if the document is too large, as 4 separate .pdf documents: (i) Section 1 (ii) Section 2 (iii) Section 3 plus supporting financial documents, and (iv) Transcripts and secondary school graduation certificates (if available at time of submission).

The nominee or their school should keep a copy of their MCFSP nomination package.

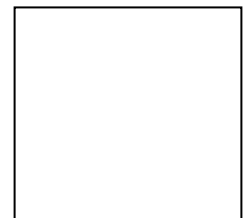
